Dear Citizens:

Champagne and Aishihik First Nations (CAFN) is developing a new Enrollment Act titled *Äghàatān*, which mean “my relatives.” This may be one of the most important laws our First Nation will ever develop. *Äghàatān* will ensure people who enroll with CAFN have ancestral ties to CAFN people. It will clearly outline and define who we are as Champagne and Aishihik people and lays out specific criteria on who can enroll as CAFN Citizens.

Because of the importance this law, we are asking for your input. Enclosed is some information to help guide you through the draft act. We have included: an Executive Summary that outlines what is in the act, answers to frequently asked questions, and notice of our upcoming consultation sessions.

If you would like to review the full draft act, copies are available to Citizens at our CAFN offices in Whitehorse and Haines Junction with reception staff or upon request as noted in the attached. Additional details are also available online at CAFN.ca.
