# NOTICE OF BY-ELECTION

*Grant of Poll Date – September 24, 2019*

**A by-election will be held for: One (1) Councillor**

**By-election Day will be Monday, October 28, 2019**

**from 11:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.**

**WHO CAN VOTE?** Champagne Aishihik First Nations citizens who are 16 years of age or older and whose name appears on the Voters' List.

**VOTERS LIST.** The Voters List is available at the Champagne Aishihik First Nations administration offices and on CAFN website. **Citizens are responsible to confirm that their name is on the Voters List. Attention CAFN Citizens:** CAFN needs your current address in order to send important information on the upcoming By-Election. **HOW CAN I VOTE?** Citizens have three voting options – voting on Election Day, voting in the traveling advanced poll voting, or voting with a mail-in ballot.

**Voting on Election Day.** Votes may be cast at any of these three locations between 11AM and 8PM on Monday October 28, 2019:

1. In Whitehorse at the Yukon Inn, Willow Room.
2. At the Takhini River Subdivision at the Walter Smith House (Madessa Ku)
3. In Haines Junction at the Da Ku Culture Centre, Main Hall

**Voting in the traveling advanced poll.** This will be held on October 15th, 2019:

1. From 10 AM to 12:30 PM in Haines Junction at the Da Ku Culture Centre, Main Hall
2. From 2PM to 4PM in the Takhini River Subdivision at the Walter Smith House (Madessa Ku)
3. From 6PM to 9PM in Whitehorse at the Yukon Inn, Willow Room

**Voting by mail-in ballot.** Only electors who do not live near a polling station will be sent a mail-in ballot package. Citizens with a mailing address of Whitehorse, Haines Junction or Champagne **will not** be sent a mail-in ballot package, unless they complete an Application to Vote by Mail form and provide it to the Chief Returning Officer.

Citizens are **responsible to confirm their correct mailing address** with Champagne Aishihik First Nations Administration (see VOTERS LIST above).

All mail in ballots need to be received by the Chief Returning Officer by 4:30PM on voting day to be counted.
