<p><b><u>Head Cook (1)</u></b>  <b><u>(8 days includes one shopping haul/day)</u></b>  <b><u>\$350.00/day</u></b></p> <p><b>Mandatory Certification:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Food Safe Levels I &amp; 2.</li> <li>• Valid 1<sup>st</sup> Aid/CPR is an asset</li> <li>• Previous Head Camp Cooking experience</li> <li>• Class 5 driver's license with your own vehicle for own transportation.</li> </ul> <p><b>Duties:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be the lead on the delivery of all meals at Camp.</li> <li>• Must supply a Healthy Menu with Gluten and Dairy Free Options.</li> <li>• Must comply with COVID 19 regulations for individual meals.</li> <li>• Camp Fire Cooking.</li> <li>• Must be able to coordinate the shopping with the Cook's Helpers and Camp Maintenance for the amount of people attending Camp of aprox 25 ppl</li> <li>• Must stay in the budget provided.</li> <li>• Coordinate the transport of the groceries safely to the 29 Mile Camp with the Cook's Helpers and Camp Maintenance.</li> <li>• Ensure the food transportation, storage, preparation and handling procedures comply with the Food Safe requirements.</li> <li>• Manage and ensure a clean kitchen space.</li> <li>• Be able to communicate well and coordinate the kitchen workers for delivery of all cooking/serving of all meals.</li> <li>• Be able to work in a remote setting as a team lead.</li> <li>• Pack up left over groceries and haul out for next camp.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Cook's Helpers (2)</u></b>  <b><u>(8 days includes one shopping haul-in day)</u></b>  <b><u>\$250.00/day</u></b></p> <p><b>Mandatory Certification:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Food Safe Levels I.</li> <li>• Valid 1<sup>st</sup> Aid/CPR is an asset.</li> <li>• Previous experience.</li> <li>• Class 5 driver's license with own vehicle for own transportation.</li> </ul> <p><b>Duties:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assist the Head Camp Cook with shopping and food orders.</li> <li>• Assist with transport of the groceries safely to the Camp, with the Head Camp Cook and Helper.</li> <li>• Assist with the grocery haul, unloading and storage of groceries at the Camp.</li> <li>• Must Comply with COVID 19 regulations for individual meals.</li> <li>• Assist Head Camp Cook with preparation of all meals and snacks to be served individually.</li> <li>• Assist in washing dishes as required in prep for next meals</li> <li>• Ensure Kitchen and serving areas are kept clean.</li> <li>• Be able to work in a remote setting and have own transportation to and from camp.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Emergency Medical Responder – Level 2</u></b>  <b><u>(8 days includes one shopping haul-in day)</u></b>  <b><u>\$350.00/day</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must have Level 2 Certification</li> <li>• Must have own transportation into camp and camp gear.</li> <li>• Must stay in camp the duration</li> <li>• Be on-call for duration of camp.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Camp Maintenance (1)</u></b>  <b><u>(8 days includes one camp set up day)</u></b>  <b><u>\$250.00/day</u></b></p> <p><b>Mandatory Certification:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Food Safe Level I</li> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup> aid is an asset</li> <li>• Chain Saw Safety</li> <li>• Safety Gear</li> <li>• Class 5 driver's license with own vehicle for own transportation is an asset.</li> </ul> <p><b>Duties:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide camp maintenance and assistance around entire Camp</li> <li>• Camp site preparation</li> <li>• Generator maintenance and servicing.</li> <li>• Cut and haul firewood.</li> <li>• Assist camp with general laborer duties such as: Camp Garbage and Recycling, taking out and hauling out garbage when required.</li> <li>• Hauling water and maintain the fire pit.</li> <li>• Help the Head Cook as required and with any heavy lifting.</li> <li>• Ensure Kitchen, Hall facilities and Washrooms are kept clean and maintained, swept and mopped when required and on the last day on August 18.</li> <li>• Be able to work in a remote setting and have own transportation to and from camp.</li> </ul>
