<p><u>Head Cook (1)</u> <u>(8 days includes one shopping haul/day)</u> <u>\$350.00/day</u></p> <p>Mandatory Certification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food Safe Levels 1 & 2. • Valid 1st Aid/CPR is an asset • Previous Head Camp Cooking experience • Class 5 driver's license with your own vehicle for own transportation. <p>Duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be the lead on the delivery of all meals at Camp. • Must supply a Healthy Menu with Gluten and Dairy Free Options. • Camp Fire Cooking • Must comply with COVID 19 regulations for individual meals. • Must be able to coordinate the shopping with the Cook's Helpers and Camp Maintenance for the amount of people attending Camp of aprox 30 ppl • Must stay in the budget provided. • Coordinate the transport of the groceries safely to the Camp with the Cook's Helpers and Camp Maintenance. • Ensure the food transportation, storage, preparation and handling procedures comply with the Food Safe requirements. • Manage and ensure a clean kitchen space. • Be able to communicate well and coordinate the kitchen workers for delivery of all cooking/serving of all meals. • Be able to work in a remote setting as a team lead. • Pack up left over groceries and haul out for next camp. 	<p><u>Cook's Helpers (2)</u> <u>(8 days includes one shopping haul-in day)</u> <u>\$250.00/day</u></p> <p>Mandatory Certification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food Safe Levels 1. • Valid 1st Aid/CPR is an asset. • Previous experience. • Class 5 driver's license with own vehicle for own transportation. <p>Duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist the Head Camp Cook with shopping and food orders. • Assist with transport of the groceries safely to the Camp, with the Head Camp Cook and Helper. • Assist with the grocery haul, unloading and storage of groceries at the Camp. • Must Comply with COVID 19 regulations for individual meals. • Assist Head Camp Cook with preparation of all meals and snacks to be served individually. • Assist in washing dishes as required in prep for next meals • Ensure Kitchen and serving areas are kept clean. • Be able to work in a remote setting and have own transportation to and from camp. 	<p><u>Camp Maintenance (1)</u> <u>(8 days includes one camp set up day)</u> <u>\$250.00/day</u></p> <p>Mandatory Certification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food Safe Level 1 • 1st aid is an asset • Chain Saw Safety • Safety Gear • Class 5 driver's license with own vehicle for own transportation is an asset. <p>Duties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide camp maintenance and assistance around entire Camp • Camp site preparation • Generator maintenance and servicing. • Cut and haul firewood. • Assist camp with general laborer duties such as: Camp Garbage and Recycling, taking out and hauling out garbage when required. • Hauling water and maintain the fire pit. • Help the Head Cook as required and with any heavy lifting. • Ensure Kitchen, Hall facilities and Washrooms are kept clean and maintained, swept and mopped when required and on the last day on August 18. • Be able to work in a remote setting and have own transportation to and from camp.
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All positions are: Responsible for providing their own transportation to and from the camp. CAFN will not be responsible to submit anyone's name via a phone call or email instruction. Each applicant will be responsible to submit an updated resume and copies of all updated certificates.
