A. Job Summary:

Reporting to the Cultural Centre Programmer of Language and Culture Department, the Da Ku Cultural Centre Interpreter is responsible for providing assistance, guidance and education to the general public and to assist the Programmer in the development and delivery of programs.

B. Main Duties:

- Participating in orientation and training for interpretive storytelling and program delivery
- Research, study and become familiar with all the exhibits and interpreters guide books, both visual and written material
- Plan and present interpretive talks and tours of the Orientation space, Life on the Land area, Changing Exhibit, and Outdoor Activity area to visitors of the Centre.
- Assist in Organizing, preparing and facilitating special events and programs
- Coordinate and deliver a weekly program, such as a campfire talk/walk talk
- Develop and maintain statistical log of visitor usage and programming data
- Write and deliver end of season report, including highlights, observations and recommendations
- Become familiar with common Southern Tutchone Language, such as place names
- Become familiar with visitor Center, Kluane National Park, and Areas of the building
- Provide customer service and warm reception via personal contact and phone
- Opportunity to learn and present CAFN heritage, traditional lands and lifestyles.
- Assist Interpreter staff with operational requirements and scheduling, opening and closing DKCC
- Assist with cultural programming initiatives and events
- Exposure to learning traditional languages and place names
- Develop individual project for research and presentation of choice of topic
- Participate in land based learning opportunities as available
