Head Cook (1)

3.0 Days – includes shopping and prep day

Salary: \$300.00/day

Duties: Prepare nutritional **AM Snack/LUNCH/PM Snack** for approximately **80 people**

- Submit Menu with Gluten & Dairy Free options with Resume
- Shop and purchase groceries and supplies on a reasonable budget provided
- Haul and Store food per Food Safe regulations at Venue
- Supervise Assistant Cook, and the Cook's Helper to ensure service areas are kept clean
- Keep cooking area clean during and at the end of the event
- **Submit receipts and leftover food is distributed as per department instructions**
- **Must have Food Safe Level I/II and previous experience**

Assistant Cook (1)

3.0 Days – includes shopping with head cook and prep day

Salary: \$250.00/day

Duties: Assist Head Cook with shopping, food prep and delivery of one Lunch and two snacks

- Help the Head cook with shopping, food storage, food preparation, service and clean up
- Set up and dismantling of serving area and assist with meal serving if required
- Ensure Kitchen Facilities and Floors are clean, swept and mopped on last day
- Other duties as required by Head Cook
- **Food Safe Level 1 is an asset**

Cook's Helper (1)

2.0 Days

Salary: \$200.00/day

Duties: Assist Head Cook and Assistant Cook with food prep and delivery of Lunch and snacks

- Set up and dismantling of serving area and assist with meal serving if necessary
- Maintain beverage station and keep serving areas clean
- Ensure Kitchen Facilities and Floors are clean, swept and mopped
- Dish washing and other duties as required by the Head Cook
- **Food Safe Level 1 is an asset**

Cleaner (2)

2.0 Days

Salary: \$150.00/day

Duties: Clean venue/hall areas and tables during and after the event of garbage and recycling. Ensure the food serving areas, beverage station is kept clean during event. Complete sweep and mop of the Hall at the end of the last day. Maintain the Bathroom facilities are stocked and cleaned at the end of each event day, swept and mopped.
