(40 people) and (60 people on Saturday). *some pick-nick style lunches</b></li> <li>• <b>Must supply a Healthy Menu with Gluten and Lactose Free Options.</b></li> <li>• Must be able to coordinate the shopping with the Assistant Cook for the amount of people attending Camp</li> <li>• Must stay in budget provided</li> <li>• Coordinate the transport of the groceries safely to Äshèyi Hall with the Assistant Cook.</li> <li>• Ensure the food transportation, storage, preparation and handling procedures comply with the Food Safe requirements at Camp.</li> <li>• Manage and ensure a clean kitchen space.</li> <li>• Be able to communicate well and coordinate the kitchen workers for delivery of all cooking/prep of all meals.</li> <li>• Be able to work in a remote setting as a team lead</li> <li>• Pack up left over groceries and transport out for the next camp</li> <li>• Ensure kitchen facility is left clean, swept and mopped.</li> <li>• Reporting to the Camp Coordinators.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Assistant Cook (1)</b>  <u>\$300.00/day x 5 days</u>  <u>\$350.00 x 1 day (Sat. June 4)</u></p> <p><b>Mandatory Certification:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Food Safe Levels I.</li> <li>• Valid 1<sup>st</sup> Aid/CPR is an asset.</li> <li>• Previous Camp Cook experience.</li> <li>• Class 5 driver’s license with own vehicle for own transportation.</li> <li>• Ability to cook and camp in a remote location</li> </ul> <p><b>Duties:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assist with the unloading and storage of groceries when needed</li> <li>• Assist Head Camp Cooks with preparation of all meals</li> <li>• Dish washing as required</li> <li>• Ensure Kitchen and serving areas are kept clean at all times.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Camp Maintenance (2)</b>  <u>(6 days includes two camp set up days)</u>  <u>\$300.00/day</u></p> <p><b>Mandatory Certification:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup> aid is an asset</li> <li>• Chain Saw Safety</li> <li>• Class 5 driver’s license with own vehicle for own transportation is an asset.</li> <li>• Ability to work and camp in a remote location.</li> </ul> <p><b>Duties:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide camp maintenance and assistance around Camp</li> <li>• Camp set up and take down</li> <li>• Ability to cut and haul firewood to the Äshèyi Hall</li> <li>• Camp site preparations one day prior, and help unpack at camp</li> <li>• Hall Generator maintenance and servicing</li> <li>• Camp Garbage and Recycling, taking out and hauling out if required.</li> <li>• Hauling water and maintain the fire pit.</li> <li>• Assist camp with general laborer duties.</li> <li>• Other duties as required.</li> </ul>
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**All positions are:** Responsible for providing their own transportation to and from the camp. CAFN will not be responsible to submit anyone’s name via a phone call or email instruction.
