Dän Ts'än Nännji (Community Wellness – People Helping People) Äshäw (Elders) Advisory Committee

In response to the recent Äshäw Senate resolution titled “Next Steps for Elders Programs and Services Review”, CAFN is seeking five to seven CAFN Elders to sit on the newly established Dän Ts'än Nännji Äshäw Advisory Committee. This committee will strengthen how Dän Ts'än Nännji supports Elders across CAFN communities. To ensure strong representation, CAFN is seeking one representative from each community, including Dakwäkäda, Canyon Creek, Shadhäla, Takhini River Subdivision, Whitehorse and Klukshu.

Committee Mandate

While ensuring Elders' voices remain central in planning, decision-making, and wellness programming, the committee will provide structured guidance to the Dän Ts'än Nännji department in the following areas:

- Advising on existing Elders programs to ensure services remain responsive and effective
- Supporting the development of new initiatives that reflect the needs, priorities, and cultural values of CAFN Elders
- Recommending changes to enhance or update current programs and services

Responsibilities of Committee Members

- Attend scheduled committee meetings
- Share community perspectives and Elders' priorities
- Review program proposals and provide recommendations
- Support communication between Dän Ts'än Nännji, CAFN Elders and the Äshäw Senate
